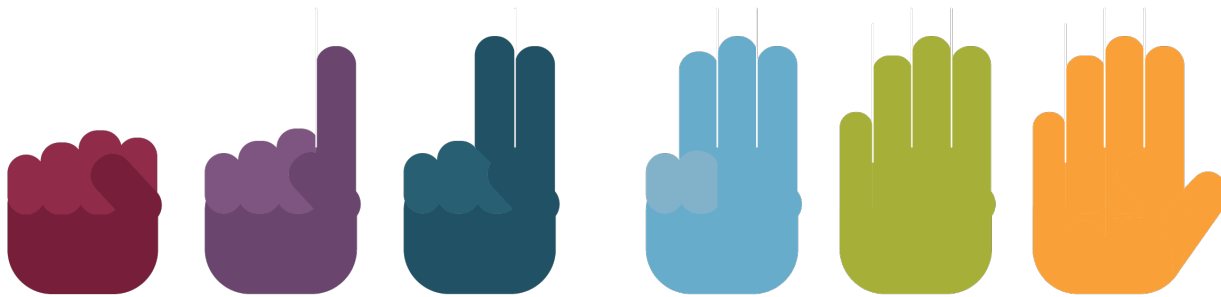


## Team Decision-Making Model: Fist to Five
