- What is the impact of on others...?
- What is another way you might....?
- What criteria do you use for.....?







- 4. Finding a solution together or making suggestions if the other is now open to suggestions: To be used only after paraphrasing and reflective items and mediating items have been used:
- Some others have tried....
- There are several other approaches...
- The research in this area shows that...
- A recent article in said that...
- Could we look at this topic together? I would like some more information also.
- 5. Finally, when you are faced with the need to speak up, but don't want to appear to be with odds with a speaker consider using the following phrases:
- If I heard you correctly...
- Can you tell me more about...
- Let me help you with...
- Can you include me in...
- Just because I am unclear, can you clarify...
- Can you help me better understand...
- Let me push back on you...
- I can offer some insight about...
- I do have an idea about...
- You might want to know that...
- I think it would help you if...
